REQUIRED INVOLVEMENT:

- Follow @schooltheworld on all social accounts and share our posts to your stories
- Post on Instagram following your trip, tagging @schooltheworld
- Assist with overall marketing when asked (video reflections, content creation, focus groups, testimonials)
- Write an article for your school/town newspaper and/or the School the World blog
- Help schedule and market information sessions (flyers, announcements, activity board, social media, etc.) and attend sessions to talk about trip experience
- Speak to your town's middle school (or other relevant groups) about your trip experience

ADDITIONAL INVOLVEMENT:

- Help start a club or chapter in your school or town
- Organize fundraising events (for books/school supplies, for a specific community, etc.) get creative!
- Student Leadership positions available for Ambassadors who return on trips
- Volunteer at our annual gala
